B.Pharmacy

It is a bachelor degree with a duration of 4 years, which includes multidisciplinary subjects related to pharmacy and a collaborative research with a vision of strengthening the healthcare of the society.

Eligibility

❖ First Year

- Pass in Intermediate (10+2) or 12th examination from a recognized central / state board or its equivalent.
- Rank obtained in TS EAMCET / AP EAMCET.
- A minimum of 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying examination with Mathematics / Biology, Physics & Chemistry subjects.

Second year (Lateral Admission)

- a) A pass at D. Pharmacy course (ER-91) with I class.
- b) Qualifying at the Entrance Examination (E-CET) conducted by Telangana State Council for Higher Education.

Scope in future

The scope of pharmacy practice includes more traditional roles such as compounding and dispensing medications, and it also includes more modern services related to health care, including manufacturing of new drugs, clinical services, reviewing medications for safety and efficacy, and providing drug information. Pharmacists, therefore, are the experts on drug therapy and are the primary health professionals who can optimize the use of medication, who can analyze the mechanism of the drug action, who design and synthesize new medications for the benefit of the patients.
